The Community Development Department will issue a Final Certificate of Occupancy for a one-time fee of \$5.00 once a satisfactory final inspection is completed by Building Codes, Fire Department, Planning, and Development Engineering.  A temporary certificate of occupancy can be issued to open the business when approved by Building Codes, Fire Department, Planning, and			
Development Services. The fee for a temporary certificate of occupancy is: \$30 for 30 days or \$60 for 120 days.  Permit Requirements:

- A business license is required for every business operating in the City.
- Once Steps 1 4 are complete, the Community Development Department will issue a Shawnee Business License.

## **BUSINESS LICENSE:**

A business license will be issued by the Community Development Department. The business license fees can be found in Title 5 of the Shawnee Municipal Code The licensing year for most business is October 1 to September 30 of each year. Most fees are pro-rated based on the month in which the license is issued. Some businesses have additional regulations and fees.
